Forced marriage is a **criminal offence** 





17,000 WOMEN IN BRITAIN

are estimated to have been subjected to 'honour' related abuse.

80%

of cases handled by the Forced Marriage Unit in 2015 involved female victims.

60%

were from South Asian backgrounds.

48%

of all cases involved young people aged 16 – 25

## FORCED MARRIAGE IS A CRIMINAL OFFENCE IN THE UK

## IF YOU SUSPECT SOMEONE IS BEING FORCED INTO MARRIAGE



- Believe what they tell you
- Reassure confidentiality
- Speak to the individual alone in a secure and private place
- Respect and recognise the individual's wishes
- Ensure the individual is dealt with in a appropriate and sensitive way
- Arrange for an independent interpreter who speaks the dialect and language of the individual if necessary.
- Contact the FMU or Police for more information or assistance
- Provide the individual with contact details of a member of staff, The Sharan Project, the FMU or the Police

## **ONE CHANCE RULE:**



- **Speak** to the individual's family or community if you have concerns, this may put the individual at significant risk of harm
- **Rely** on family or community members to act as an interpreter for you
- Share information with anyone, unless you have the individual's consent
- Allow the individual to leave the premises with members of their family or community if you believe they may be in danger
- Attempt to mediate between parties or between an individual and their family.
   Mediation can be extremely dangerous and can put the individual in grave danger.
- Decide it is not your responsibility to follow up the concern
